The new summer lunch menu starts when we return with week one. The menu may be subject to change at short notice due to stock and delivery issues.

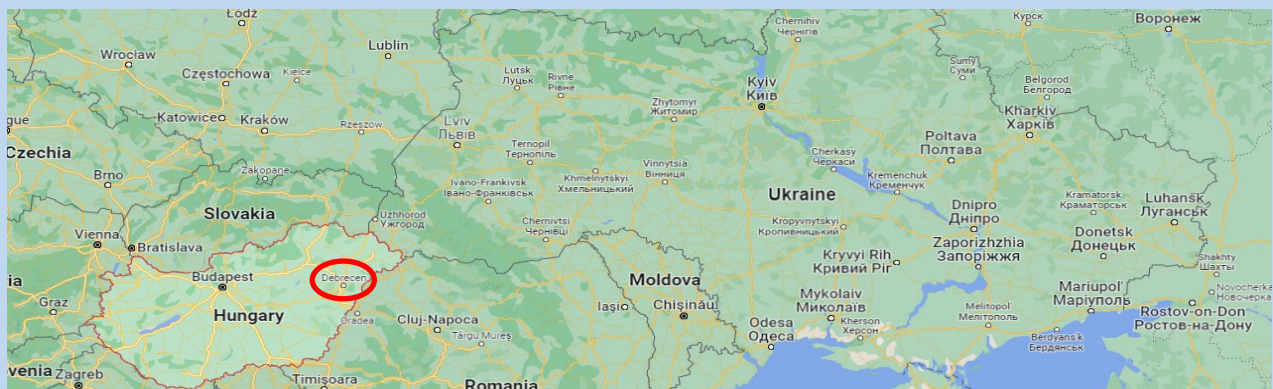
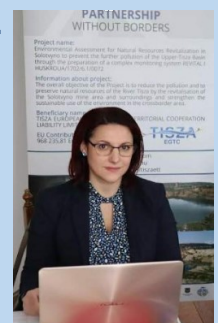
The new menu now includes a 'vegetarian' day once a week.

Her cousin is involved with the refugee crisis through the Tisza charity and we have made links with them and will be doing some fundraising next term. We are also planning on the children communicating with the refugee children showing them support. Please find below some information about the charity and the work they have been doing since the war started. The Schools in the local area are now refugee centres.



Humanitarian work in the Hungarian-Ukrainian border area coordinated by the Tisza EGTC

The European Territorial Association with Tisza Limited Liability was established in 2015 and operates in the Hungarian-Ukrainian border region in accordance with the guidelines set out in the founding documents and the Association's integrated development strategy.

Due to the Ukrainian-Russian conflict that erupted on 24 February 2022 and has lasted for more than a month, Hungarian-Ukrainian cross-border relations today are mainly aimed at easing migratory pressure on the border region, collecting humanitarian aid and organizing their delivery to Transcarpathia, in which Tisza ET takes on a role.
