Little Dolly grew up in the foothills of Tennessee's Great Smoky Mountains, with her 11 siblings. She didn't have much, but she was gifted with a lovely voice and that was worth more than any treasure. She became the most popular singer on the country music scene. With her unique voice and fabulous image, she became a total superstar. Dolly decided to do something great for children who loved her and started a special library that would send books to kids in need, from her hometown to the other side of the world. She also built a theme park and became the most successful woman in show business, she now owns radio stations, TV channels and record companies.
