Mia is Star Learner for being kind and supportive to all her friends.

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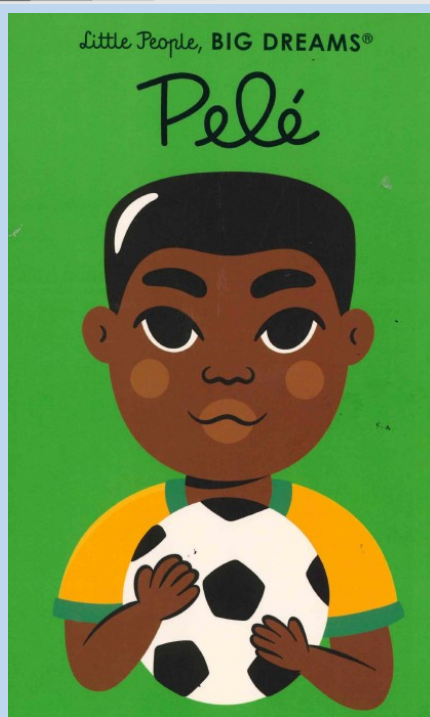


WHAT MAKES AN OUTSTANDING PERSON

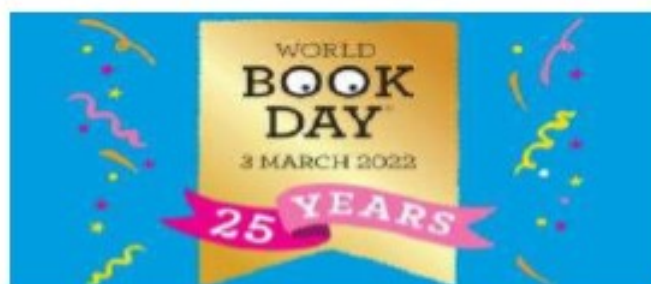
