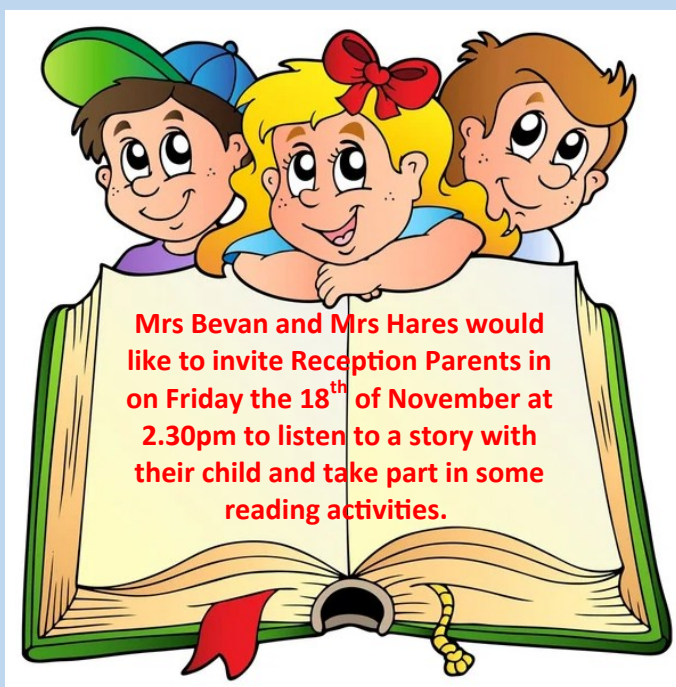

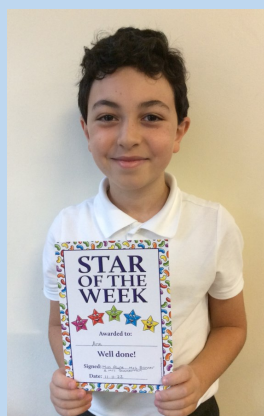

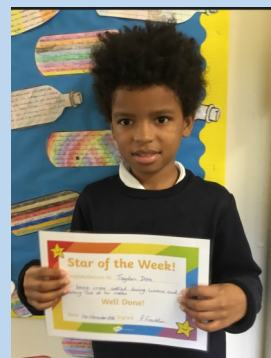
Congratulations to our Star Learners

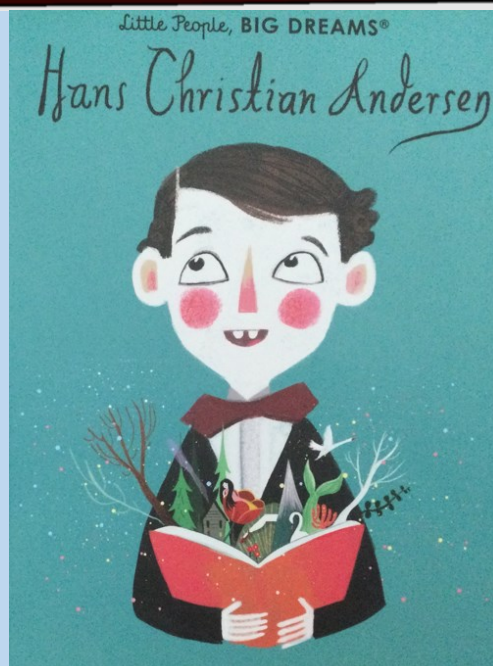
WHAT MAKES AN OUTSTANDING PERSON
