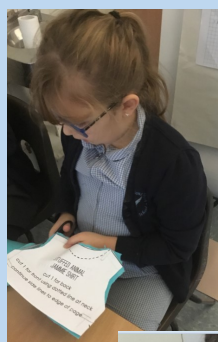


Dear Parents/Carers,

We have had an update from the Department of Education. From Monday 17th January people who are self isolating with Covid 19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative on both days 5 and 6 and do not have a temperature.

For example, if your child has a negative test on day 5 and the morning of day 6 they can return to School on day 6.

If either results are positive they should continue to isolate until they get two negative results on two consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self isolation, whichever is earliest.

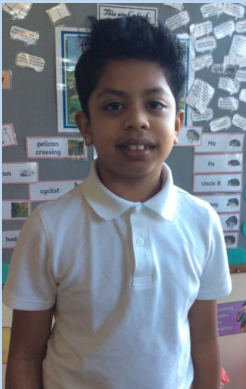

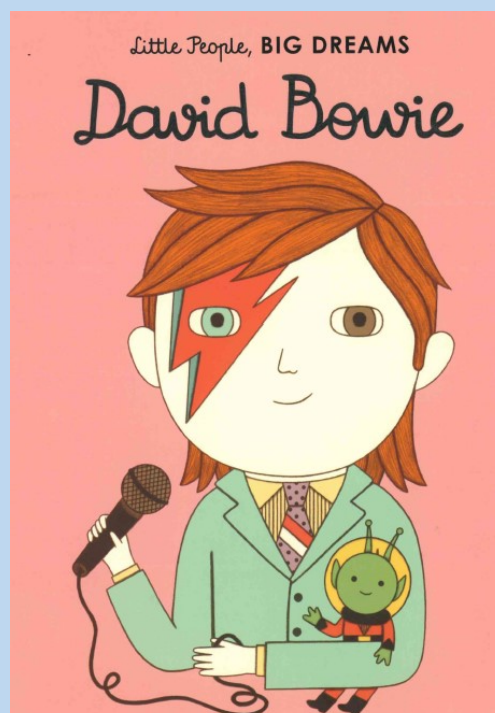


### WHAT MAKES AN OUTSTANDING PERSON
