School Council

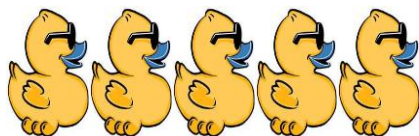
The School Council are once again holding a Christmas Raffle.
