Thank you to the parents for all their comments in the parent survey and those who spoke with the inspectors.

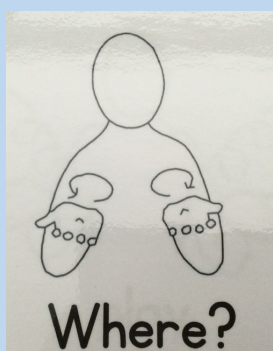
The result is not known yet and the report will be shared with all once it is published, which should be in the next 30 days.

John Lennon

John Lennon was born in Liverpool in 1940. His mum taught him how to play the banjo and bought him his first guitar. John was in his band the Quarrymen when he met Paul McCartney. They changed the name to The Beatles and played at The Cavern along with George and Ringo. After 12 albums John left the band and met a Japanese artist called Yoko who shared his ideas of world peace.
