Lola could be Star Learner every week for always working hard and trying her best but this week we have been doing talk 4 writing in English and she has produced an excellent story map. Well done Lola

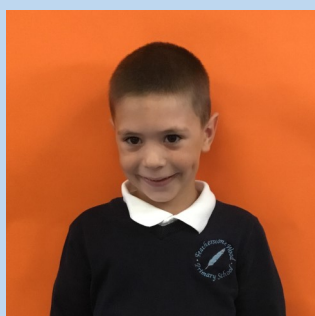

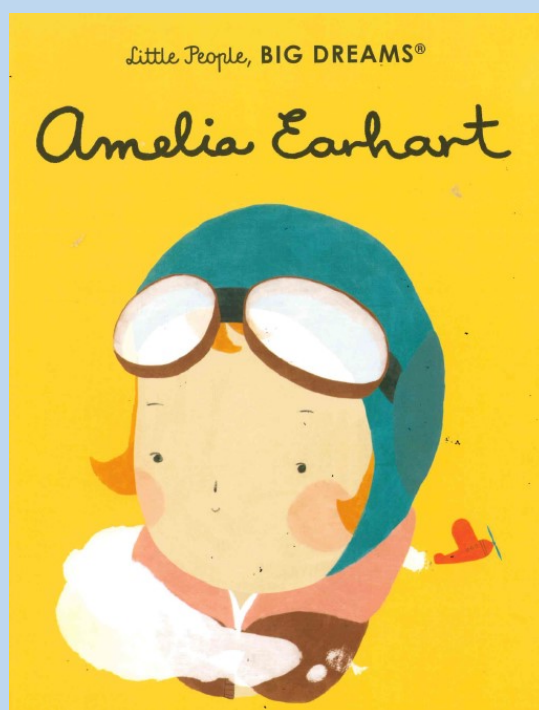


WHAT MAKES AN OUTSTANDING PERSON

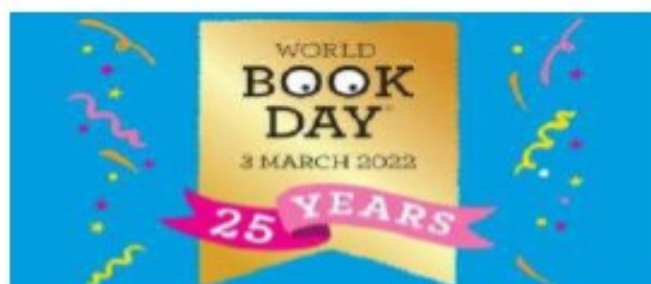
