Understanding Science and Technology

<u>Science:</u> We will be exploring the circulatory system and how to keep our bodies healthy. We will use secondary research to help us alongside some observations.

<u>Computing:</u> We will be learning to use spreadsheets to keep track of money. We will use our knowledge of percentages to help us.

English

<u>Writing:</u> We will begin by reading Manfish and explore how to choose the correct vocabulary for your audience choice.

Reading: This term we will be focusing on using synonyms and antonyms in a text to help us understand. We will be practising our retrieval skills.

<u>Grammar:</u> We will be revising cohesive devices including fronted adverbials and the use of relative clauses.

Spelling: We will be working on our personal spelling lists based on Key Stage 2 spellings. We will continue to focus on spelling rules and patterns learnt in previous years to consolidate our application in preparation for SATS.

Understanding Arts and Culture

Music: We will be learning to sing 'Music and Me' and learning to play the glockenspiel alongside this.

Art: We will experiment with Modroc and produce our own Maya masks.

Understanding Health and Well-Being
