REMINDER - Due to some of our children having severe nut allergies, please do not put items in your child's packed lunch box that contains nuts, this includes Nutella.

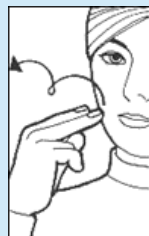
Free School Meals - If you think that your child/ren could be entitled to Free School Meals please apply directly through the HCC

Each Monday will focus on a 'new' inspirational person (taken from the beautiful 'Little people, Big Dreams' books) as part of a weekly assembly theme.

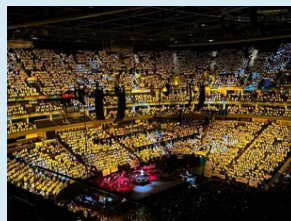
