



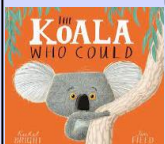
SPRING CURRICULUM MAP



YEAR 1

Reading

Reading is so important for children to communicate and write. Making sure you read with your child every day will support their phonics and writing skill.



Guided Reading

This term we will be starting guided reading in Year 1. We will be building our comprehension skills by answering questions about our new book.

Phonics

We will continue to follow the Monster Phonics programme to reinforce our knowledge of all phonemes and graphemes. This term we will focus on our blending skills and recognition of sounds ready for preparation for Phonics screening in Summer 2.

English

This half term we will begin by looking at 'The Lion Inside'. We will be building our vocabulary and reinforcing the use of capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will be describing the characters and their surrounds and eventually re-telling the story.

Maths

Our focus in maths this term is numbers 11-20 we will be looking at how to represent them in lots of different ways, we will also be building on our understanding of value and linking it with real life. We also are completing mastery maths fluency every day to close any gaps in our learning.

Science

In Science this term we are looking at animals including humans. We will be learning about the different diets there are, habitats and learning about the different body parts. We will explore through investigations and use our predicting and observing skills to understand.

PSHE

In PSHE we are going to be looking at computer safety and making sure we know how to be safe online. We will also be focusing on being responsible and understanding feelings. We will be having lots of discussions ensuring children know who their safe adults are that they can go to if they feel overwhelmed.

RE

We are looking at belonging in Spring term. We are going to be discussing what it means to belong somewhere. Then we will move on to what Easter means to Christians.

Art

Our focus in Art is for the children to learn about primary and secondary colours. We will be doing lots of experiments by mixing colours and predicting what colour it will become. We will then look at the work of Wassily Kandinsky.

Geography

In Geography our focus is our surrounding area meaning we will be learning about key history and locations in Stevenage. We will also start to learn map skills by going on hunts around the school using a map, this will build the children's map reading skills.

Computing

Our focus in computing in Spring is coding. We are going to make a very own animated scene with characters. We will learn how to make them move, perform actions and talk.

Music

We will be using the music room this term and learning how to play some instruments. We will be finding the beat, tempo and pitch we will be continuing using body percussion as well as instruments. We will build towards a performance to our class once we have learnt our new song.
