Bliss Balloon Race Results

It has been so exciting waiting for the balloon tickets to be returned to school! Mrs Hoare has received letters from some of the finders of the balloons - a copy of one is attached. Thank you to everyone who made this event so successful - a total of £310 was raised by selling 250 balloons.

We have had tickets returned from the local area, Norfolk and Denmark! We have measured the distances and as two balloons were found so close together we have decided to have an adult prize and a child's prize.

The winning child ticket was number 093 which was bought by Kamil Maczan in Year 5. Kamil's balloon travelled all the way to Hvide Sande in Denmark - a total of 442 miles! The balloon was found on the beach there by a German lady who was on holiday in Denmark. Kamil wins a family ticket for four to the Stevenage pantomime - Aladdin.

The second balloon which was found in Hvide Sande, Denmark, was bought by Mrs Barber in our EYFS. Her balloon ticket was found by an 8 year old German girl also on holiday with her family in Denmark. Mrs Barber has won four VIP tickets to Roller City in Welwyn Garden City.
