#### Featherstone Wood School Governors

The school has undergone two Governor Health & Safety Inspections sínce November 2015, one was a planned inspection the other was unannounced. Both inspections met the criteria with evidence of good record keeping, maintenance regimes and required test certification. There were also a number of good practices *in place, that were not required, but* had been implemented by staff. Records show that staff are well trained and competent in many safety practices. Health & Safety will be continuously monitored and assessed as the school year continues.

The Governors also regularly review school policies to ensure that they are up to date and fit for purpose. The **Acceptable Behaviour Policy** ensures children, parents and teachers have a protected and safe environment and are all treated equally. Parents are important role models to their children and set a code of conduct that will last a lifetime so it's important to get it right and hopefully this guidance will help.
