
Dear Parents and Carers,

E-Safety

Concerns have been raised about Snap Map which was launched on Wednesday. The app allows video clips and photos that members have posted publicly to be discovered on the map, while members who have chosen to share their location can also be seen on the map by those they have added as 'friends'. The location-sharing feature lets people 'locate exactly where you are, which building you are in and exact whereabouts within the building'.

Please be vigilant and if you want to switch off Snap Map location sharing please follow the below instructions:-

- When in photo-taking mode, pinch the screen to open Snap Map
- Touch the setings cog in the top right corner of the screen
- Tap 'Ghost Mode' to switch off location sharing
