# School Day

Please may I remind you that the doors open for Key Stage 1 at 8.50 – 9.00 a.m. If children arrive after this time they will receive a late mark. School finishes at 3.25 p.m.

For Key Stage 2 the doors open from 8.40 – 8.50 a.m. If children arrive after this time they receive a late mark. The school day finishes at 3.15 p.m.

We have recently been experiencing a high incidence of children being collected late at the end of the school day. I know on occasions that a delay in collecting your child is unavoidable, but we do not provide after school care on a regular basis. If you might be late to collect your child it would be appreciated if you could call the school before 3.00 p.m. in order that there is enough time to get the message to class.

## Please could you also ensure that we have up to date contact numbers as there have been several occasions when we have been unable to contact parents in an emergency.

There have been a few examples of children using bad language on the playground. As parents and carers we work very hard to protect our children but they can access it through TV programmes, the internet, out in the street and local shops, visiting friends and from older siblings.
