Dear Parents and Carers,

Unfortunately it has come to my attention that over the past few weeks we have had several incidents of intimidating and unpleasant behaviour on site. These have taken place near KS2 and Early Years. I would like to take the opportunity to remind you that this type of behaviour is totally unacceptable for a school and will not be tolerated. We understand that not everyone will get along but to be passing comments about other parents and their children, either to their faces or to other parents, is unacceptable. If it continues, those responsible will be banned from the school site. I trust there will be no further incidents.
