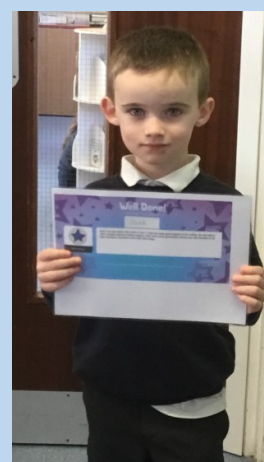
Ruby is our Star Learner for an excellent attitude towards her learning. She has been participating in class discussions and working really hard to present her work
