

Latest SATS Results 2015

We are very proud of our Year 6 pupils. The children, staff and parents have worked very hard to achieve these results. We are sure that as the children leave us and move to their secondary schools this summer they will do so knowing they can hold their heads up high and that they will continue to develop and be independent learners at secondary school and beyond.

Featherstone Wood is an inclusive school with a significant number of children with special educational needs. Where these needs are related to cognitive function, this can have an impact on our 'headline' results. This need to be taken into account when parents & carers are trying to understand the success of the school.

In 2015, 35% of the Year 6 cohort had this type of special education need with 59% disadvantaged. This means our Year 6 results show that, overall, children achieve good or better standards as they travel through our school.

Progress

The government target for progress is 91% making two levels progress from KS1 to KS2.

In 2015, we achieved:

• Two levels progress in Reading: **71%** • Two levels progress in Writing: **94%** • Two levels progress in Maths: **82 %**

Attainment

The government target for attainment is 87% children reaching Level 4 by end of KS2.

In 2015, we achieved:

- Level 4+ Reading: **76%** (Test)
- Level 5+ Reading: **18%** (Test)

- Level 4+ Writing: **76%** (Teacher Assessment)
- Level 5 Writing: **24%** (Teacher Assessment)

- Level 4+ English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling: **76%**
- Level 5+ English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling: **47%**

- Level 4+ Maths: **76%** (Test)
- Level 5+ Maths: **24%** (Test)

The government target for combined Level 4+ in Reading, Writing & Maths is 65%. In 2015, we achieved **76%**.
