1. What has happened to support your child's Special Educational Needs over the last year?

All respondents were able to outline some of the support that was in place for their child. 2 parents mentioned 1:1 support-

Action: RS to ensure that parents understand the need not to become reliant on 1:1 support and how this is provided most successfully.
