- **Swimming Travel Costs** - To ensure that children are able to achieve the National Curriculum targets for swimming we have spent the amount outlined below to pay for travel costs.

- **Employment of a Highly Experienced Sporting HLTA** – We have a Sporting HLTA that we employ to contribute to the profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.

She undertakes high quality PE lessons, supporting Teachers. She runs Lunchtime clubs. She also runs More Able PE sessions to raise the level of PE and challenge these pupils further. Many Pupil Premium children are part of these sessions.

- Stevenage Sporting Futures (SSFT) The school subscribes to the Stevenage Sporting Futures
 Team for a cost of £2,433,00. We have committed to a three year partnership with SSFT. The impact
 of being in partnership with this organisation is to increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all
 staff in teaching PE and sport as they provide Subject Leader training, staff training on all areas of PE
 to ensure teachers are confident and delivering high quality PE sessions.
 SSFT also ensure a variety of physical activity opportunities across the whole school both in school
 and externally including a range of competitions, such as in Mini Olympic tournaments for KS1 and
 KS2, Cross Country, Athletics etc.
- **Host more competitions on site** As well as taking part in competitions led by SSFT we have increased participation in competitive sport by hosting more competitions on our school site such as Dodge ball competitions, a Speed Stacking competition and a fundraising Fun Run.
- PE Kit for Vulnerable families We set aside \pounds_{50} for providing PE Kit for children that require one due to family circumstances. This ensures that they are able to take part in all PE and Sporting opportunities provided in school.
- **Sporting Equipment** We also set aside some budget for when we need to buy more PE sporting equipment.
