Sports Premium Report 2013-14

The Sports Premium has been introduced this year to promote school sports across the country. Featherstone Wood has received £5,325 in additional funding, which we are using on a wide range of activities, including:

- Swimming - Year 2 swim every week.
- Elite Sports are a professional body that have expertise in team games. They run sports sessions and teach team games, rules and control.

The classes that have taken part in Elite are:

Spring Term - Year 1 and 2

Summer Term - Year 3 and 4

Autumn Term - Year 5 and 6

- Stevenage Borough Football Club Sports are run alongside the Football team to encourage and inspire young people. Children have focused on agility, perseverance, coordination, team work alongside other key skills.
