Black school shoes.
Black, grey or white socks or tights.
Grey trousers, skirt or dress.
Shorts or blue gingham dress.
White shirt, blouse or polo shirt.
Sweatshirt, jumper, or cardigan in navy with or without logo.

When the weather is bad, all children are required to change into a separate pair of shoes – plain black shoes or plimsolls are adequate. Nail varnish should be removed before coming back into school after the weekend or holiday.

Jewellery

In school, stud earrings may be worn but need to be removed for PE activities. If parents or carers provide tape for their child, then they must apply this themselves. A watch may be worn in school.

Hair

Hair in school must be tied back with an appropriate tie, hairband or scrunchie. These should tie in with school colours. Children will not be permitted to wear bright colours such as pink in their hair or large flowers or bows for example.

Please ensure exceptionally short or patterned hair will have grown back before the start of term and that the hair has not been coloured in any way. Braids are great on holiday in the Summer but once again must be removed for the return to school.

All equipment and clothing should be clearly labelled so that it may be returned if lost.
