

Uniform

Boys:

- Black school shoes
- Black, grey or navy socks
- Grey trousers or shorts in the summer
- White shirt or polo shirt
- Sweatshirt and/or fleece in navy with or without logo
- A school baseball cap for the summer term

Girls:

- Black school shoes
- Black, grey or navy tights
- Black grey or white socks
- Grey dress or skirt
- Blue gingham dress for the summer term
- White blouse or polo shirt
- Navy blue sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece with or without logo
- A school baseball cap for the summer term

- When the weather is bad, all children are required to change into a separate pair of shoes – plain black shoes or plimsolls are adequate. Nail varnish should be removed before coming back into school after the weekend or holiday.

Currently all of our school uniform is produced affordably through the Tesco Uniform scheme and can be ordered online.

PE Kit:

- Suitable trainers for outdoor PE
- Plain white t-shirt (with or without school logo)
- Navy shorts
- Plain navy tracksuit bottoms and sweatshirt can be worn in the cold winter months

Please ensure your child's PE kit is in school every day. Bring it in on Monday and keep it in school until Friday. It can then be washed at the weekend.

Please be aware a hoody, of any kind, is not part of the uniform or PE kit. School book bags and PE bags are available at the school office to purchase.

Uniform Continued

Jewellery:

- In school, stud earrings may be worn but need to be removed for PE activities. If parents or carers provide tape for their child, then they must apply this themselves.
- A watch may be worn in school.

Hair:

Hair in school must be tied back with an appropriate tie, hairband or scrunchie. These should tie in with school colours. Children will not be permitted to wear bright colours, such as pink, in their hair or large flowers or bows for example.

Please ensure exceptionally short or patterned hair will have grown back before the start of term and that the hair has not been coloured in any way. Braids are great on holiday in the summer, but once again must have been removed for the return to school.

All equipment and clothing should be clearly labelled so that it may be returned if lost.

Each day you will need:

- A water bottle – clear, labelled and with a sports style cap
- Book bag with your reading book and diary inside
- Spellings/times table book
- PE Kit - The PE kit must be in school Monday to Friday

We appreciate parents ensuring their children are dressed according to the school uniform requirements and have the correct equipment every day. Sanctions will be in place for children not following the rules.
