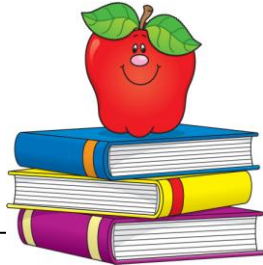


Welcome back to Featherstone Wood Primary School. Hopefully you had a great Easter holiday!

Literacy

In Literacy we will be learning to:

Write Poetry

We will be writing calligrams where the shape of the poem matches the theme of the poem

Writing instructions

Children will write their own instructions, inspired by our topic work 'The Enchanted Forest.' They will include resources, imperative verbs and adverbs for precision.

Word Work

We will be identify and discussing powerful verbs, adjectives and adverbs which describe the Enchanted Wood.

Mathematics

The children will learn:

- To find fractions of shapes or amounts and now that all the parts must be equal to the whole.
- Read the time on the clock to the nearest 15 minutes.
- Adding and subtracting any 2 digit number using an efficient strategy and explain their thinking verbally or apparatus or pictures.
- Count in 2s, 5s, 10s

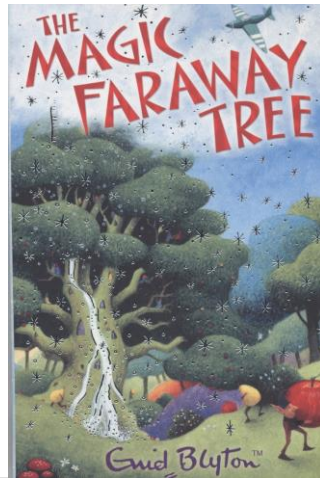
Science

In science we will be learning about the following ideas in *Living Things and their Habitats*:

- *To explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive.*
- *Mapping a habitat and identifying its inhabitants*
- *Identifying minibeasts in microhabitats*
- *Researching habitats around the world*
- *Making a variety of food chains.*

Music

Children will continue to develop their rhythm skills with a variety of percussion instruments.



Key Topic Vocabulary:

Habitat, wood, forest, living, food-chain, classify, map, sort.

PE

The children be learning use simple tactics in games and will also be attending swimming lessons.

Geography:

- Children will learn to create simple maps using the four points of the compass for direction.
- They will be creating keys to identify areas on the map.
